To help make your stay with us enjoyable, we have established campground rules. We believe these rules will help make Bunganut Lake a place to enjoy vacation and many vacations to come. If we can assist you in any way, please let us know. A SINGLE VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE FOLLOWING RULES WILL CONSTITUTE GROUNDS FOR IMMEDIATE TERMINATION OF THE RIGHT TO OCCUPY THE CAMPSITE AND EVICTION FROM THAT SITE.

**RESERVATIONS:** RESERVATIONS ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED. If an error is made with a reservation, we will do our best to accommodate and/or compensate on a case by case basis, however a refund is not guaranteed.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** A Deposit of \$35.00 is required to hold a campsite. The Deposit is non-refundable and non-transferable within one calendar week of scheduled check in date. NO REFUNDS FOR INCLIMENT WEATHER.

**CHECK IN / OUT TIME:** Check out is at 1:00pm; Check in time is between 3:00pm – 8:00pm daily. ALL CAMPERS MUST CHECK IN BY 8:00pm.

**REGISTRATION:** All CAMPERS and VISITORS must register before 8:00pm at the office before going on any campsite. Base rates are for a family of five consisting of two adults and three children under 17 years old. Rates for additional persons and visitors are listed in the office.

**VISITORS:** Visitors MUST stop at the office, register, and pay a visitor fee. Campers are responsible for letting their guests know there is a visitor fee, or pre-paying for them. Only one visitor vehicle per site, so please make arrangements with your guests before they arrive. You are responsible for your visitors, and must follow the same rules as campers! Visitors may not enter the campground until 10:00AM. Guests must leave by 11:00PM unless they paid for an overnight visit. VISITORS WHO DO NOT REGISTER WITH THE OFFICE WILL BE CONSIDERED TRESPASSING. VISITORS MAY NOT BRING PETS INTO THE CAMPGROUND.

**MINORS:** You Must be 21 Years old to rent a campsite. Anyone younger than 18 years old must be on their own campsite by 10:00 PM unless they are accompanied with parent or other reliable adults. MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 SHALL NOT BE LEFT UNATTENDED IN THE CAMPGROUND.

**OFFICE / STORE HOURS:** Hours are posted outside Office / Store.

**SPEED LIMITS:** The speed limit is 5 MPH on campground property and STRICTLY ENFORCED! NO ATVs, Mini Bikes, Electric Golf Cars or Mopeds in Campground. Motorcycles are allowed only when entering and leaving the campground, but are not otherwise to be used on campground property. FOR YOUR SAFTEY: no skateboarding, rollerblading, or scooters on campground roads. Bicycles are permitted in the campground, however all one ways must be followed.

**PETS:** NO PETS ON SITES B1, B2, B3 or in THE BEACH CABIN or TRAILER RENTALS. Only one dog per site unless permission is obtained from the office. Pets may not be left un-attended and MUST BE LEASHED AT ALL TIMES. All owners are expected to clean up after their pets. No pets are allowed in the REC HALL, STORE, RESTROOMS, LAUNDRY ROOM, PLAYGROUND, OR IN THE BEACH AREA. NO PETS IN THE WATER. All pets should have proper papers for vaccinations, which must be presented at registration. MAINE STATE LAW requires proof of rabies vaccination.

**SITES & CAMPFIRES:** DO NOT MOVE PICNIC TABLES FROM SITES. DO NOT MOVE FIREPITS. No Vehicle washing is allowed. Sites are expected to be kept clean and orderly. Be sure fires are out before leaving the site.

**QUIET HOURS:** Between the hours 11:00pm and 8:00am, noise interfering with the peaceful enjoyment of nearby occupants is strictly prohibited.

**DISORDERLY CONDUCT:** Abusive or profane language, drunkenness, deliberate property damage, or violation of the campground rules will terminate your stay at Bunganut Lake Camping Area. Parents ARE responsible for damage caused by their children. Throwing rocks anywhere in the campground is strictly forbidden.

**FIREARMS:** NO pellet guns, bb guns, slingshots, or any other type of firearm. If Law Enforcement, please show ID when checking into the office.

**TREES:** Do NOT cut down any trees or limbs. Please do NOT climb any trees, swing from branches, peel bark, or carve with a knife.

**BEACH:** Enter water from the sand beach only. Do not push or shove others on the floats. Fishing is not allowed in any swimming area. No beverages or containers of any kind are allowed on the beach. NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.

**BOATS:** Check with office for use of a boat ramp and docking. MAINE STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT ALL BOATS HAVE CURRENT REGISTRATION AND MILFOIL STICKERS. NOTE: All vehicles must be returned to their campsite upon launching boats. STATE OF MAINE LAW requires one life jacket per person; anyone under 18 must wear one at all times. NO BOATS OVER 18ft. JET SKIS / JET BOATS ARE NOT PERMITTED. No campground guests are permitted to launch and or dock boats unless permission is obtained from the office.

**RUBBISH:** YOU ARE RESPOSIBLE for your own trash. ALL TRASH MUST BE BAGGED. Please check with the campground staff on where to dispose of it.

**DUMP STATION:** There is no charge for campers using our Dump Station. Check with the campground staff for pump out pricing and dates.

**RESTROOMS:** Please keep our restrooms clean. Children should be accompanied by an adult in restrooms and showers. Restrooms are not a playing area. Do not wash dishes or laundry in restroom sinks. Outside sinks at each restroom may be used for dishes and/or laundry.

**BUNGANUT LAKE CAMPING AREA ASSUMES NO RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY INJURY, LOSS, OR ACCIDENT TO CAMPERS, GUESTS OR VISITORS OR THEIR PROPERTY. ALL CAMPERS, GUESTS, OR VISITORS SHOULD TAKE REASONABLE PRECAUTIONS AGAINST ANY SUCH LOSS OR DAMAGE.**

ALL CAMPERS AND VISITORS AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD BUNGANUT LAKE CAMPING AREA HARMLESS FROM ANY LOSS, DAMAGE, CLAIM, DEMAND, SUITS, JUDGEMENTS, OR LIABILITIES WHICH BUNGANUT LAKE CAMPING AREA MAY INCUR AND ANY COSTS, EXPENSES AND ATTORNEYS FEES TO WHICH BUNGANUT LAKE CAMPING AREA MAY BE PUT, ARISING FROM ANY INJURY OR RESULTING FROM THE USE OF BUNGANUT LAKE CAMPING AREA FACILITIES BY CAMPERS OR GUESTS, UNLESS SUCH LOSS OR DAMAGE WAS OCCASIONED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF BUNGANUT LAKE CAMPING AREA.
